End of Analyzer 1 support - An old gem is going into retirement

From August 2011 we will no longer be providing support for Analyzer 1.

For more than 12 years, Analyzer 1 and its intuitive user-interface served many researchers worldwide as a useful and reliable processing tool, offering a variety of analysis methods and graphical displays. The first version goes back to spring 1998, where it introduced its innovative modular history tree concept, moving on to set the highest standards in scientific EEG and ERP analysis software.

Over the following years we constantly extended and enhanced its functionality, however, in the meantime Analyzer 1 has reached a point where it can no longer keep up with today's new developments and is therefore approaching its well-deserved retirement. Its successor, Analyzer 2, was released over two years ago, and -

though fully compatible with Analyzer 1 - provides many new features and builds on state-of-the-art technologies making it ready for future challenges. So, what does this mean for Analyzer 1 users? Analyzer 1 licenses are valid indefinitely, but there will be no further software updates or user support provided. We therefore strongly advise you to plan in a move to Analyzer 2 in the near future. Please contact your local distributor for details on upgrading.
