### Brain Products EEG & fMRI Workshop

As in previous years Brain Products exhibited at the annual meeting of the Society for Psychophysiological Research (SPR). This year's conference, which was held in Berlin / Germany from October 21st – 24th, attracted almost 1000 scientists from all over the world – way more than in past years. Many attendees not only took time to attend the various sessions but also frequently visited the technical exhibition that accompanied the meeting.

As we assumed that many of our customers would join the 49th Annual Meeting of the SPR, we also held an EEG & fMRI workshop at the CHARITÉ Berlin right after the conference (October 25th).

The program of the workshop included various topics ranging from "Pain & Gain of EEG & fMRI" to the presentation of new approaches for fMRI imaging-artifact correction in ultrahigh-frequency EEG. In a live demonstration directly in the MR-Scanner, the proper preparation of an EEG & fMRI recording was shown, crucial experimental issues discussed, and then - during the recording - the impressive online artifact correction was demonstrated. These data recordings were used afterwards during an interactive session to show how

to successfully correct the data offline for various types of MR-related artifacts. Among the speakers were Brain Products' Dr. Ingmar Gutberlet as well as Dr. Petra Ritter, Robert Becker (M.Sc.) and Frank Freyer (M.Sc.) from the EEG-fMRI Group of the Berlin Neuroimaging Center, whom we would like to thank very much for this excellent workshop.

Within a few hours of announcing the workshop, all of the places were booked out.
