Award for a Distinguished Contribution in EEG Research 2010

As in previous years, Brain Products and “Deutsche Gesellschaft für Psychophysiologie und ihre Anwendung (DGPA)” once again announce the “Young Scientist Award for a Distinguished Contribution in EEG Research” for 2010.

Besides a certificate and a trophy, the award includes a contribution amounting to € 1000 (for trips to conference or research projects) as well as one year’s membership of DGPA free of charge.

The award will be granted for outstanding empirical or theoretical work in the field of psychophysiological EEG research. The work should be available as a manuscript or have already



been published. Nominees should not be older than 45.

Please submit your application (in triplicate) and a short CV to the President of the DGPA, Professor Norbert Kathmann, Institut für Psychologie at the Humboldt-Universität Berlin (Rudower Chaussee 18, 12489 Berlin) by April 15th, 2010. A panel of experts selected by the Board of DGPA will appoint the successor to last year’s winner Dr. Tobias Heed (Hamburg University). The award will be officially presented at the annual DGPA Meeting “Psychologie und Gehirn” held in Greifswald from June 10th to 12th, 2010.
